Team Leader (m/f) - Sustainable Production and Consumption in the Myanmar Garment Industry

Location: Yangon and surroundings, Myanmar

Contract duration: October 2013 until September 2014 (prolongation unlikely, but possible)

The Project

We are looking for a Team Leader (m/f) as long-term expert who shall be in charge of managing a sequaproject in Myanmar which is being financed by the European SWITCH programme. The contract duration will be limited until September 2014. The position shall be filled as soon as possible.

The Team Leader leads the Project which shall provide advisory services in Yangon and environment in the garment industry and possibly in other sectors. The project's objective is to improve sustainable production and consumption in the garment industry in Myanmar and set provision for the replication towards other sectors. Specifically, the Project will increase the competitiveness of SMEs by establish a group of around 25 Myanmar Garment Manufacturers as show cases and make them ready to comply with European standards and establish business relations with EU clients. In addition, more than 100 SMEs in Myanmar will benefit from company audits to reduce energy consumption, improve productivity levels and reduce waste. The Project will also work on the improvement of workers' safety.

The local partners are the "Union of Myanmar Federation of Chambers of Commerce and Industry – UMFCCI" and the "Myanmar Garment Manufacturers Association – MGMA". The Project will be supported by the "Sheffield Chamber of Commerce and Industry", the "Confederation of the German Textile and Fashion Industry" and the "Association of Development Financing Institutions in Asia and the Pacific – ADFIAP" by the provision of consulting services.
